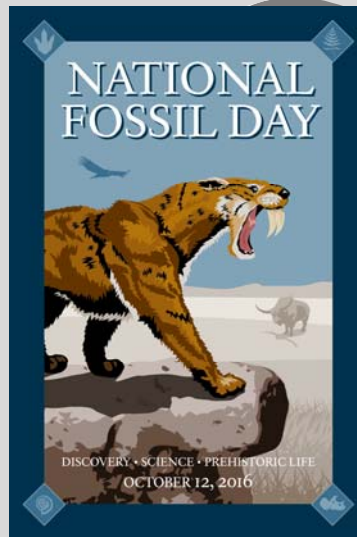


Fossil Extravaganza 2016
